## Eligibility to Take Food - Home Letter of Proxy

If you are ill, disabled, or otherwise cannot make it to a pantry yourself, all Mid-Ohio Foodbank partner agencies use a proxy process where you can send someone to pick up food for you. You can use a proxy by:

1. Filling out and submitting a Letter of Proxy. (See below)

OR

2. Submitting a <u>handwritten note</u> stating that you are in need of food assistance including your first and last name, your full home address, and the first and last name of the person you would like to pick up food for you.

<u>Upon arrival to the pantry or produce program,</u> the person picking-up the food must show the Letter of Proxy (1) or the handwritten note (2) to the registration staff. This can be shown as a hardcopy or as an electronic copy. (Photo or email representation of either letter is acceptable.) <u>The person picking-up the order must have his or her own valid photo ID.</u>
